BOERNE CHAPTER



The 2009 Tour of Yards, sponsored by the Boerne Chapter of the Native Plant Society of Texas and the Cibolo Nature Center is an annual activity dedicated to educating the public of the many benefits of utilizing native plants in the landscape. This years tour provides a rare opportunity to walk private land in Texas and see firsthand and up-close the hidden beauty and resilience of the Hill Country natural landscape.

Entrance is free and there is no requirement to visit the yards in any particular order... however, you will save considerable time by planning to visit the Cordillera Ranch yard *before* the River Mountain Ranch yard. There is a security gate where you may **exit** Cordillera Ranch (see map), however, you cannot enter Cordillera at this point.

The Spanish Pass and River Mountain Ranch properties are the largest and will take the most time. Allow at least 1 hour for each. Both have small trails that may be uneven and rocky. Sturdy shoes appropriate for a hike are suggested. A liability waiver will be required for those wanting to walk the trails at these properties.

The Fair Oaks Ranch and Cordillera Ranch yards are each approximately 2+ acres in size. It is estimated 1/2 hour to 45 min. would be sufficient to view these yards. 22

A. 31384 REXON CIRCLE, FAIR OAKS RANCH

Directions: From IH10 take exit 546 to Fair Oaks Pkwy. Continue on Fair Oaks Pkwy till it ends at FM 3351 Ralph Fair Road. Turn left on FM 3351. In approx. 1.5 mi. turn left on Silver Spur Trail then left to Rolling Acres Trail and right to Raxon Circle.

City of Fair Oaks Ranch ordinance prohibits signs to be posted in public rights of way, therefore no directional signs will be posted, except in the yard of the participating home.

B. 122 GREYSTONE POINT, CORDILLERA RANCH

Directions: Enter Cordillera Ranch from Hwy 46. Let the guard know you are attending the Tour of Yards. Continue on Cordillera Trace to Greystone Point on left.

* Cordillera Ranch covenants restrict posting of signs, therefore no directional signs will be posted, except in the yard of the participating home.*

C. 105 CLEAR CREEK CIRCLE, RIVER MOUNTAIN RANCH

Directions: From FM 474 take Kreutzberg Road to River Mountain Drive to Clear Creek Circle or Take shortcut from Cordillera: Cordillera Trace to Kreutzberg Road to River Mountain Drive to Clear Creek Circle.

D. 305 SPANISH PASS, BOERNE

Directions: From Boerne travel North on Main St. and turn right onto the IH10 West feeder/access road. Turn right on Spanish Pass (just before the rock yard). Continue to end of Spanish Pass. Ranch gate will be on right. Follow signs on the one lane wide private drive.

Please drive with extreme caution and slowly at all times!
