Summary of Position:

This is a paid stipendintern position that serves as a secondary counselor of camper groups. You must enjoy working with children ages 5-12 years of age and have a general love of nature. This position requires patience, flexibility and high energy. Previous experience working in a camp environment or day care is preferred. Attendance at planning meetings is required. Reliable transportation is required.

Minimum availability to work 4 weeks of summer camp and specified training days is also required. The weeks of camp operations are: June 8th-Aug.7th 2020.

You must be 16-17 years old to apply for this position. Resume and letter of recommendation required with applicationfor this position.

Note: We are monitoring closely the COVID-19 guidelines from our state and local officials and may adjust dates accordingly. Our camps are outdoors, and we will also be putting in place very specific hygiene and distancing measures in place to ensure the safety of campers and all counseling staff.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Emphasis on camp safety as a top priority. Knowledgeable of safety management plan and emergency protocol. Certification in CPR and First Aid will be provided as part of training.
- Responsible for up to 15 youth campers from the time the campers arrive in the morning at 9:00 a.m. until they are seen leaving camp for the day with the authorized pick up at 1:30 p.m.
- Act as mentors and role models to all campers and Counselors-in-Training (CITs).
- Work with camp administration to support a safe and successful camp environment.
- Maintain documentation as requested by Camp Directors.
- Provide a safe and friendly experience for all children at camp with the goal to always foster friendship and respect towards each other and the environment.
- Notify lead counselor immediately if there is a health problem or concern regarding a camper.
- Attend camp meetings.
- Complete an objective paper and project determined by Camp Director as an opportunity to extend and evaluate the learning experience.
- Facilitate and participate in daily camp activities with the campers focusing on environmental awareness and stewardship.
- Coordinate daily camp activities with your lead counselor and CITs.
- Maintain an appropriate public profile that supports and promotes the Cibolo Nature Center and its mission.
- Perform camp duties as requested by the lead counselor and Camp Directors.
- Support camp promotion at Cibolo Nature Center and community events.
- Is evaluated at mid-term and exit by the Camp Directors.
- May occasionally help with safety checks on the trails.
- Everyone will help in daily clean up at the end of the camp day.
