For 25 years, the Cibolo Nature Center has practiced conservation education in our greater Central Texas neighborhood. The Herff Farm is a new addition to the center and it will serve as an outdoor classroom for teaching skills such as gardening, composting, bee-keeping and rainwater harvesting. These and other simple skills for sustainable living will provide their community with practical ways to live in harmony with nature.

Currently, the inspiration garden relies on drip irrigation and at peak times only uses 1,100 gallons a week to provide water to the produce grown in the garden. A yard the same size with only grass would use 1,800 gallons a week! In the future, the farm will eventually contain a rainwater catchment system and use solar energy!
